Kindergarten 2027 enrolments for children born between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023 close on Friday, **24 July 2026**.

Pre-primary 2027 Enrolments - enrolment in Kindergarten does not guarantee a position in Pre-primary next year. Therefore, all Kindergarten students need to re-apply for Pre-primary 2027.

If you have friends or neighbours who have Kindergarten or Pre-primary aged children, and would like to attend the school in 2027, please see our website to download a copy of the application form.

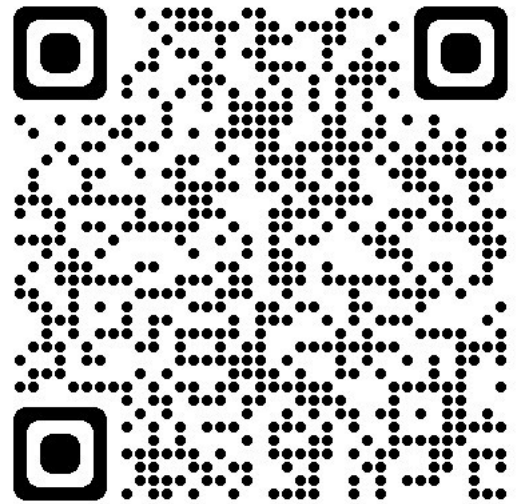
